Towards a local Action Plan – Pilot Actions

WHAT IS AN ACTION PLAN?

An action plan is a document providing details on how the lessons learnt from ECOWASTE4FOOD will be implemented in order to **improve the Policy Instrument** identified by each partner in the Application.

It specifies the nature of the actions to be implemented; the timeframe; the players involved; the costs (if any), and funding sources (if any).

Action plans are prepared during Phase 1 based on experiences shared amongst partner and implemented during Phase 2.

THE ACTION PLAN

ACTION 1

- Background: lessons learnt from project that directly help the delivery of this action
- Action:** list what is to be implemented
- Players involved:** list organisations and explain their role in delivering the action
- Timeframe**
- Costs** (if relevant)
- Funding sources** (if relevant)

PILOT ACTIONS

Pilot Actions are implementation related activities dedicated to testing a new approach.

This usually refers to the transfer of existing practices

It can also relate to a new initiative jointly designed by the regions during phase 1 and jointly implemented in phase 2

PILOT ACTIONS

To be eligible for support from the programme, pilot actions need to fulfil the following three conditions:

Relevance

The pilot action needs to clearly contribute to the policy instrument tackled in the region where it is proposed. As such, it should be part of the action plan of that region.

Interregionality

The pilot action needs to clearly derive from the cooperation. Usually it allows a partner to test, in its region, an approach that has been developed in another region. Pilot actions need to be clearly related to the interregional learning process.

Additionality

The pilot actions have to represent additional activities that would not be carried out without the support of the Interreg Europe programme. The region proposing a pilot action should therefore demonstrate the reason why this action cannot be taken over by the relevant local, regional or national funds.
